SECTION 3– PROCEDURES

1. Normal Procedures:

There is an “Entertainment System” on/off toggle switch in the cockpit that is accessible to the flight crew. The switch is normally in the ON position.

NOTE: The “Flight Display” System is a non-essential accessory that has no value to cockpit or flight operations, and as such, is powered by the non-essential electrical bus.

2. Abnormal Procedures:

No change. The aircraft abnormal procedures call for non-essential electrical busses to be shed.
